Our Junior High program teaches students the organizational and study skills necessary for success in higher grade levels. Our professional and dedicated staff guides students, inside and outside the classroom, through our small group Student Advisory Program, sports, academic competitions, and community service initiatives. ADVANCED MATH PROGRAM

Fairmont offers an elite mathematics program that is among the top educational programs in the country. Beginning in Fairmont's Junior High program, and continuing through High School, the advanced math track provides a highly individualized approach to math education. Students of all abilities receive the customized instruction they need to achieve their highest potential in High School courses, and on important college entrance exams.
