Pick-up and Drop-off

As the new school year approaches, we would like to confirm with you our pick-up and drop-off procedures. Please take time to look over these procedures and guidelines. Careful planning has gone into these procedures in order to ensure the maximum safety for all of our children.

DROP-OFF

7:30 am – 8:00 am (Extended Day fees apply PS-5)

- Preschool students report to room A and Pre-K students report to room D.
 - Licensing requires all Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten students be signed-in every morning, in-person in the Front Office. Use the iPad kiosk in the Front Office. Sign-in your child using your assigned, unique pin code.
 - The front parking lot is reserved for Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten parents and visitors. Please do not park your car along the red curb, and do not leave children unattended in the car at any time.
- Elementary and Middle School students will go to the MPR

7:50 am

- Middle School students can visit the library, access their lockers, and go to class for a 8:00 am start time.

8:00 am – 8:30 am

- Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten students report to their classroom.
- TK-1st students will go to the west side playground
- 2nd-5th will go to the east side basketball court
- Middle School to class (start at 8:00)

EXTENDED DAY

Preschool – Pre-Kindergarten

- Students may be picked up at 2:45 pm. No additional charge from 2:45 pm - 3:45pm. For extended care from 3:45 pm - 5:30 pm, students must be enrolled in our Extended Day program.

*Please note: If you need to pick-up your child early, please make arrangements with your child's teacher and the front office.

PARKING PROCEDURES

The speed limit in all school parking areas is 15 mph. Please drive slowly at all times, please stay off your cell phone, and follow all posted signs. No left turns are allowed from either parking lot during campus hours.

Preschool – Pre-Kindergarten

All Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten students need to be walked into the school and signed-in at the Front Office. Please park in the front parking lot by the playground. Do not leave unattended children in your vehicle at any time.

TK – 8th Grade Students

The east side parking lot, near the basketball court, is reserved for school parents to park and escort their children safely inside the east gate. A crossing guard is provided every morning for additional safety. Parents and Students must use the crosswalk and follow the directives of the crossing guard on duty. All students must be accompanied by a parent if walking in.



CAR LINE PROCEDURES

Car line service is available each morning and afternoon. Please support safe car line drop-off and pick-up procedures in the following ways:

- Have your child ready to exit the car as soon as you approach the school.
- Pay close attention and follow directions from staff and faculty at all times.
- Do not park or leave your vehicle while in the drop-off line.
- Drive courteously and with caution. 15 mph
- Do not pull around cars (or skip the line) when waiting in the drive-up line. Please keep moving forward as space opens up in front of you to ensure efficiency for all.
- Please pull forward as far as possible so that as many cars as possible can fit into the active pick-up zone.

No left turns on to La Palma are allowed out of either parking lot at any time between 7:30 am-5:30 pm.

The west side (turf side of the building) is for drive up only. If you would like to park and walk your student/s to class, please park on the east side near the basketball courts and walk your child onto campus.

Please see below for grade-specific information, and follow the procedure for your youngest child:

Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten Students- Green Route on Map

All preschool and pre-kindergarten students need to be walked into the front office and signed-in. Parents, sign-in and sign-out your child every day at the kiosk in the front office. When arriving, walk your child to class.

TK-2nd grade students, west side of campus- Pink Route on Map

7:30 am - 8:30 am

2:45 pm - 3:30 pm.

3rd-8th grade students, east side of campus- Orange Route of Map

7:30 am - 8:15 am

3:10-3:45 (3rd-5th)


3:20 pm-3:45 pm (6th-8th)

***We will kindly ask you to move to the end of the pick-up line if you arrive before your designated pick-up time**

Extended Day Program

- Extended Day fees apply to all Preschool and Elementary students between 7:30-8:00 am and 3:45-5:30 pm.
- At 3:45 pm all students who have not been picked up will be taken to assigned areas and will be signed into Extended Day. Parents may either sign up for Extended Day for the full year or pay a daily \$30 drop-in fee when students are picked up. Extended day sign-up can be found on Blackbaud in the Resources.
- If your child is staying for Extended Day we encourage you to send an additional snack to school.

Drive Up and Parking Procedures



If you will not be using the car lines, please park in the designated parking and utilize the crosswalks that will be supervised by our staff for safety.

The front parking lot (near the office) is only for our preschool families who are dropping off and/or picking up their students and siblings.



APPLICANT LIVE SCAN Fingerprint Services Locations and Hours of Operation

Below is a link to where Live Scan fingerprinting services are available to the public. The preferred location is updated as additional information is received. However, applicants are encouraged to contact the Live Scan providers in advance to verify their current operating hours, fees, etc.

IMPORTANT PLEASE READ:

- Government fees are required for the State (DOJ) and Federal (FBI) level criminal history record checks. Additional fees may also be required (e.g., license or certification fees).
- Locations identified by “BNR (Billing Number Required) provide live scan services only to applicants with agency billing numbers identified on their Live Scan forms. These sites may collect rolling fees only – they do not collect any other fees.
- Rolling fees vary from location to location and cover only the operator’s cost for rolling the fingerprint images.
- Applicants must present valid photo identification to the Live Scan Operator. Expired identification cards will not be accepted.
- If you already have finger prints completed for another company or institution they do not transfer over from institution to institution. You will have to get fingerprinted for Fairmont Private Schools.
