9TH - 12TH GRADE	ANNUAL TUITION RATES
<b>One Payment</b> — Payment in full by July 1, 2025.	\$32,446
<b>Two Payments</b> — Payment of 70% due by July 1, 2025 and 30% due by December 1, 2025.	\$33,325
<b>Monthly Payment</b> — 10-month payment plan through Electronic Fund Transfers (EFTs) with the first payment due August 1, 2025 and the last payment due May 1, 2026.	\$33,450

A deposit of \$1,500 is due at time of enrollment. **Sibling discount: \$500.**

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED FEES	FEES
<b>Application/Assessment Fee</b> — This fee is for new students only. The application and assessment fee must accompany the application. This fee is non-refundable.	\$130
<b>Registration Fee</b> — This is a one-time non-refundable fee for new students only.	\$500
<b>Graduation Fee</b> — This fee is a one-time non-refundable fee that is added to the student's account in the year that he or she graduates (12th grade only).	\$600

<p><b>Language Support - Adapted Classes</b> — Students are evaluated and assigned an appropriate amount of language support based on their assessment. They remain in their assigned language support (L2 or L3) for the entire school year and may be reassessed prior to the start of the next academic year.</p> <p>Students are charged the maximum Language Support Fee until they are evaluated during their orientation. If, after testing, a student becomes eligible to reduce their level of language support, the tuition will be adjusted to reflect the assigned level.</p>	<p>L2 — \$4,750 L3 — \$17,650</p>
