For three hours each day, Fairmont teachers focus on the skills most important to lifelong academic success: reading, writing, and mathematics. Part of each day is devoted to group work and learning stations. Teachers meet with small groups to differentiate and individualize the learning experience. When students are not working with the teacher in their small group, they rotate through a variety of learning stations that reinforce the daily lessons, promote independence, and encourage problem-solving. Students are assessed during the first few days of the program to determine summer placement.




