## ATTENDANCE POLICY

A maximum of ONE absence for any reason is allowed per semester. Missing 20 minutes or more of a class session is considered an absence. Upon the second absence, the student becomes ineligible to earn credit for the course. Please call the front desk of your campus to report absences.

## COURSE MEETING TIMES

**Mondays:** Students meet with their instructor via zoom to begin coursework.

**Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays:** Onsite courses at Prep. Remote courses meet via zoom.

**Fridays:** Students work independently and may schedule check ins with their instructor during office hours.

## COURSE TYPES

**On Site:** Courses are held on-site at the Prep.

**Zoom:** Students attend course at the designated times via zoom. No recordings available. Students need a laptop or desktop computer with a functioning camera and microphone to Zoom and work from home. A second screen and headphones with a microphone can be very helpful.

### Asynchronous - Online Courses:

- Monday: Students meet with their instructor virtually for a benchmark check at 9 am.
- Tuesday - Friday : Students work independently following course outlines provided to them using our online platform Edmentum.
