<b>Registration fee</b> — The registration fee is for new students only. This is a one-time non-refundable fee.	New student — \$500
<b>Application/Assessment fee</b> — This fee is for new students only. The application and assessment fee must accompany the application. This fee is non-refundable.	\$100
<b>Technology-Enhanced Curriculum (TEC) fee</b> — In our ongoing efforts to further develop our technology-enhanced programs, this non-refundable annual technology fee will advance student learning and enrich classroom curriculum.	P - 5th grade — \$200 6th - 12th grade — \$400
<b>Graduation fee</b> — This fee is a one-time non-refundable fee that is added to the student's account in the year that he or she graduates (grade 12).	\$500

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

Our billing procedures and payment options have been developed for the convenience of Fairmont's parents.

**Credit card** — Credit cards are accepted for one-payment plan and two-payment plan options.

### Option A — One-Payment Plan

Submit one payment for total charges, due July 1, 2019, and receive a **\$250 discount**. The discount will be forfeited if payment is not received by the due date.

### Option B — Two-Payment Plan

Tuition is paid in two installments, with a total of a **\$125 discount**: 70 percent of the tuition is due on July 1, 2019; the remaining 30 percent is due on December 1, 2019. The discount will be forfeited if payment is not received by the due date.

### Option C — Ten Electronic Fund Transfers (EFTs)

Families who wish to pay monthly must complete the EFT Authorization Form. This form will allow Fairmont to deduct payments from your bank account on the 1st or before the 5th of every month. Returning families who used EFTs for the 2018-2019 school year must complete the authorization form only if their bank account information has changed; otherwise, your account on file will be charged. There are 10 EFT payments for the school year beginning August 2019 through May 2020.

Applicants to Fairmont Preparatory Academy are encouraged to apply by our "Priority Admission" deadline of 12/20/19. After this deadline, candidates are invited to submit their applications for the fall 2020 semester to "Prep" anytime. Under our rolling admission policy, acceptances will be issued as space for the fall semester is available.
